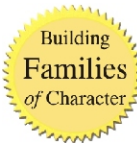

Thank you very much for your prayers on our behalf. In our last update, we explained that the price to ship our container had increased significantly, and that our departure would be delayed. We trusted that God had a plan, and we asked you to pray. We have seen God answering your prayers!

So, many of you have contributed to meeting our needs through your prayers and generous donations. We cannot thank you enough. It is exciting to share with you that the money needed for our tickets has been raised. Also, though not at 100%, we have enough monthly support to get started on the field and feel that God would have us leave for Zambia. We almost have enough money to ship our container, but are lacking the funds to handle it once it arrives in the country. We are confident that God will provide for this need in advance of it's arrival. With all this in mind, we have set a new departure date for the middle of April, and are preparing to ship our container and purchase tickets shortly.
