1. _____ Jesus
John 1:12 — emphasis is placed upon one's accepting or receiving the message that Jesus taught, the light he shed on man's understanding of the dilemma of sin.
2. _____ or _____ Jesus
John 1:12; Acts 16:31; Mark 16:15-16 — emphasis is placed upon a person's confidence and trust in the gospel truth regarding Jesus' solution to the sinfulness of each person.
3. _____ Upon Jesus
Romans 10:13 — emphasis is placed upon a person's reaction to the conviction of their sinfulness and certain judgment from God.
4. _____ & Be _____ — Some _____ the Message
Acts 2:37-41 — emphasis is placed upon a heart attitude toward sin (repent) and an action (baptism) that indicated that the person had received the message.
