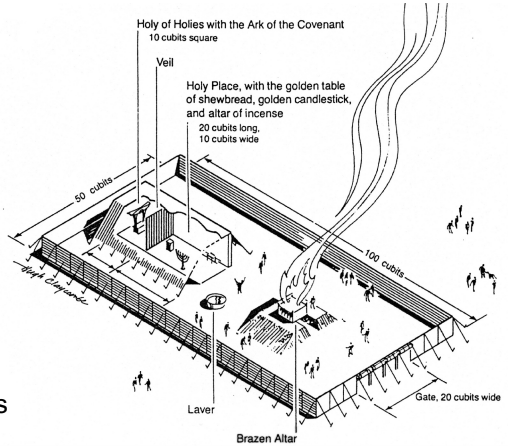


Purpose of the Tabernacle:

Exodus 25:8; 29:42-46

God alone determines how man can approach Him.

- God initiates the tabernacle. Exodus 25:1, 8-9
- God is the architect for the tabernacle. Ex 25-31
- Tabernacle served as Israel's worship center for 500 years (from Moses to Solomon).



- 37 Bible chapters devoted to it – 13 in Exodus, 18 in Leviticus, 2 in Deuteronomy, and 4 in Hebrews.

Dimensions of the Tabernacle:

- Outer Court – 150' x 75' x 7½' Exodus 27:9-18; 38:9-20
- Building. Exodus 26:15-37; 36:20-38
 - Holy of Holies – 15' x 15' x 15'
 - Holy Place (inner court) – 30' x 15' x 15'
 - Rooms Divided by a Veil
