- 1) Israel at Sinai – 19:3, 14-18; 24:15-18; 33:18; 34:29-30
- 2) Dedication of the Tabernacle – Exodus 40:33-38
- 3) Dedication of the Temple – 2 Chronicles 5:13-14; 7:1-3
- 4) Ezekiel's Description – Ezekiel 1 (v. 1-4, 28)

2. The “Glory of God” – a Glimpse of What is to Come

Now let's look forward from Jesus transfiguration...

- 1) Jesus at Trial – Matthew 26:63-68
- 2) God's Voice to You – Hebrews 1:1-3
- 3) Final Book of the Bible – Revelation 1:1, 12-18
- 4) Jesus' Second Coming – Matthew 24:30; Revelation 19:11-13
- 5) Our Eternal Home – Revelation 21:1-2, 9-11, 23-24

This grand theme of Jesus' glory runs throughout the Bible. It is the substance of our eternal life with God in heaven.

Jesus, during His ministry, claimed to be the very one who is the glory of God. For man to enter into God's family and enjoy God's glory for all eternity Jesus must suffer on Calvary and pay man's sin debt.
