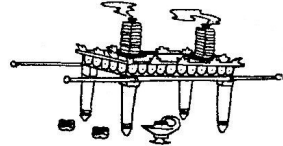


- Instructions to build the table – Exodus 25:23-30
- Record of building the table – Exodus 37:10-16

"showbread" = bread of faces, or presence. This bread represented an offering of each tribe presented at the face of, or the presence of, God. They needed Him for their sustenance and recognized that need by presenting his offering.



"This bread consisted of twelve loaves made of the finest flour. They were flat and thin, and were placed in two rows of six each on a table in the holy place before the Lord. They were renewed every Sabbath (Lev 24:5-9), and those that were removed to give place to the new ones were to be eaten by the priests only in the holy place (see 1Sa 21:3-6; comp. Mat 12:3-4)." – *Easton Bible Dictionary*, E-Sword Bible software
