



Today we return to *The Gospel of Jesus Christ According to Luke*. We stepped away from our study in August 2017 as we concluded Luke 9.

Luke 1:1-4 – God used Luke, a highly-educated physician, to travel extensively and interview the eye-witnesses of Jesus’ life. Luke was the historian of New Testament times. He wrote the histories of Jesus and of the Apostles who fanned out over the Roman world to carry the gospel to the ends of the earth. Theophilus, a high-class convert to Jesus Christ, learned the “certainty of those things, wherein thou hast been instructed” from the two books in our New Testament which God inspired Luke to pen – *The Gospel According to Luke* and *The Acts of the Apostles*.

Luke wrote these two credible histories to strengthen the faith of the 1st century believers. They continue to strengthen the faith of today’s followers of Jesus Christ as they provide us with credible eye-witness accounts of what Jesus and His Apostles did, and what they taught. Join us as we travel the land of Israel with Jesus and His original followers. You’ll discover the wonder of Jesus for yourself!
