B.L.U.F. (Bottom Line Up Front): *Talk to Him about Him – about your passion for His greatness to be manifest all around you.*

What does it mean to pray "Hallowed by Thy name"? Have three conversations with your heavenly Dad:

### 1. What is His \_\_\_\_\_? ...His \_\_\_\_\_

Your name is used as a substitute, or identifier, of all that you are as a person. When your name is used, one thinks of you as a person. "Hallowed" = sanctified, set apart, holy

***My passion is for the greatness of His Person to be manifest all around me – for His Person to be set apart in every place as supreme.***

### 2. What is He \_\_\_\_\_? ...His \_\_\_\_\_

From the names of God and from what the Bible reveals about Him, we identify characteristics of His person. We call these characteristics "attributes." God's attributes reveal what His is like as a person.

### 3. What is His \_\_\_\_\_ in My Life? ...His \_\_\_\_\_

This amazing heavenly Dad is involved in my life! How?

To "pray without ceasing" is to go through your day seeing Him in everything, all around you.
