

Sanctification is intrinsically intertwined with the person and ministry of the Holy Spirit in your life.

- Indwelling has to do with *residency* in your body.
- Filling has to do with empowering you for service.
- Sanctification has to do with holiness or Christlikeness in your living.

Meaning of Sanctification — becoming like Christ.

Process of Sanctification — seeing Christ in His Word & being transformed into

His image.

1. The of Sanctification 1 John 3:2

"appear" — to make manifest .

"for" — because: • Christ unveiled

We see Him

We become like Him

2 Corinthians 3:18; 2 Peter 3:18; 2 Corinthians 7:1

Our sanctification depends on how well we "see" Jesus Christ.

2. The of Sanctification

How does the Holy Spirit accomplish this in our lives?

1) The Short Version Hebrews 12:14

This short version emphasizes YOUR part. You can be sure that the Holy Spirit will do His part in seeing that this happens.

"holiness" — sanctification

"follow" — to follow after, to pursue, to persecute.

Go for it! How? Consider the longer version....

2) The Long Version 2 Peter 1:1-11

- ⇒ God's Part v. 1-4
 - 1) Salvation v. 1
 - 2) Daily Strength v. 2-3
 - 3) Precious Promises v. 4

...that by these we might become partners with God in the displaying of His nature to a fallen world. See v. 4b

⇒ Our Part v. 5-7

"And beside this" — for this very cause .
"giving" — contributing alongside, adding on your own part "diligence" — to exert one's self, to do one's best "add" — supply abundantly .

What am I to work so diligently to add alongside of what God has already accomplished?

- 1) Virtue moral strength, moral energy
- 2) Knowledge understanding, practical experience
- 3) Temperance self-control
- 4) Patience endurance
- 5) Godliness reverence, respect for God
- 6) Brotherly Kindness care, fondness, affection
- 7) Love concern for the benefit and need of others

We must pursue holiness by cooperating with the Holy Spirit as He adds to our lives ...

- · Moral strength to enable us to do right
- · Discernment to enable us to know right
- Self-Control by which we resist temptation
- Endurance to bear up under persecution
- Right behavior toward God
- · Right behavior toward man
- · Others life

Such a life will display the nature of God before a world which has become corrupted by sin. Such a life is sanctified...set apart from sin and uniquely God's for the accomplishing of His purposes in our world.
