

Sanctification is intrinsically intertwined with the person & ministry of the Holy Spirit in your life.

- Indwelling has to do with residency in your body.
- Filling has to do with empowering you for service.
- Sanctification has to do with holiness or Christlikeness in your living.

Meaning of Sanctification — becoming like Christ Process of Sanctification — seeing Christ in His Word & being transformed into His image Result of Sanctification — the fruit of the Spirit

The result of the work of the Holy Spirit is a life in whom He has developed His fruit. His fruit is the nature of Jesus Christ. This is what a sanctified life looks like.

walk under the power & influence of the Holy Spirit His transforming work takes shape. Here's what it looks like... See it in Jesus, then in yourself.

Let's examine nine aspects of this fruit produced by the Holy Spirit:

1) Love — action on behalf of the beloved; not emotion, but acts accomplished for the benefit of the one loved.

Jesus Christ — 1 John 3:16

You — Ephesians 5:1-2; Philippians 1:9

2) Joy — not a slaphappy silliness resulting from positive circumstances, but a deep-seated acceptance of whatever God allows, knowing it's purpose. It is based upon my relationship to Him. Jesus Christ — Hebrews 12:1-3

You — Phil. 4:4; 2 Cor. 7:4; 6:10; James 1:2-5; Rom. 5:1-5

Peace — tranquility in the face of tumult, calm in the face of conflict. Peace is built upon right relationships.

Jesus Christ — Mark 4:36-40

You — John 14:1, 27; 16:33; Psalm 46:1-3; James 3:17

4) Longsuffering — patience, steadfast under pressure, endurance of wrong under ill-treatment.

Jesus Christ — 1 Peter 2:19-25 You — James 5:7-11

5) Gentleness — kindness that accomplishes something useful Jesus Christ — His handling children, woman caught in adultery.

You — Ephesians 4:32 (kind)

etc.

6) Goodness — moral or spiritual excellence

Jesus Christ — Acts 10:38

You — Romans 15:14; Ephesians 5:9

7) Faith — trustworthy, dependable

Jesus Christ — Lamentations 3:22-23

You — Revelation 2:10

8) Meekness — yielded, submissive spirit.

Jesus Christ — 2 Corinthians 10:1

You — 1 Timothy 6:11; Colossians 3:12

9) Temperance — self-control

Jesus Christ — hungry, thirsty, 40 days without food and water,

yet He had full control.

You — 1 Corinthians 9:25

See Jesus' nature revealed in Scripture and the Holy Spirit will transform you into His likeness. Sanctification looks like Jesus!

3. _____ for Spirit-Led Living v. 23b-26

Notice v. 23b — Law condemns the works produced by the flesh (v. 19-

21). However, no law condemns the fruit produced by the Spirit!

v. 24 – you are done with fleshly living. See 6:14.

v. 25 – if you are alive spiritually, let's see it in action!

v. 26 – refuse to live for selfish pride.
