



"How hard it is for a rich man to get saved, but with God anything is possible" exclaimed Jesus in Luke 18. Well it didn't take long for God to show us an example of a rich man getting saved...and what a full dose of salvation he got!

**B.L.U.F.** (Bottom Line Up Front): *We're here to "seek and save" the lost (v. 10)*

Let's understand Jericho and Zacchaeus (v. 1-2) then we'll examine three insights to this amazing story.

**1. The \_\_\_\_\_ that Leads You v. 3-4**

- 1) God Had Been Working v. 3a  
"sought to see Jesus" = continual action in past time.
- 2) Zacchaeus Abandoned Pride v. 3b-4

---

---

**2. The \_\_\_\_\_ that Saves You v. 5-6, 9-10**

- 1) The Decision v. 5-6, 9b Also Romans 4:3; Genesis 15:6; Galatians 3:6
- 2) The Cause v. 5-6a That look, name and call.
- 3) The Result v. 9a, 10 Salvation entered that house that day!  
Salvation concepts:
  - Lost/found (Isaiah 53) – Jesus sought the lost
  - Destruction/rescue (save) – Jesus rescued from destruction

---

**3. The \_\_\_\_\_ that Changes You v. 7-8**

v. 6 ends – Jesus & Zacchaeus go to his house  
v. 7 – everyone begins to gossip  
v. 8 – probably the next morning. Your life reflects on what people think of Jesus.
