## JESUS' RESURRECTION

Four events that are included in each of all four gospels – tomb is empty, angels testified, women came and saw and testified, some of the apostles and others did not believe them and/or doubted. One thing is missing from each – the actual resurrection event.

<p>Early (dawn) Sunday a group of ladies come to the tomb with spices.</p> <p>Stone rolled away. Body gone. Perplexed.</p> <p>Two angels appear. "He is not here, but is risen...."</p> <p>Remember...</p> <p>Women report news to the apostles &amp; others.</p> <p>Apostles did not believe them.</p> <p>Peter went to the tomb, saw the linen clothes but no body and left wondering.</p>	<p>Early (dawn) Sunday Mary &amp; Mary came to the tomb.</p> <p>An earthquake had removed the stone. An angel sat on it. The Roman guard were afraid.</p> <p>An angel spoke to the women "He is not here: for he is risen...come...go tell his disciples...He will meet them in Galilee...."</p> <p>Women ran to disciples. On the way Jesus appeared to Mary &amp; Mary.</p> <p>Roman soldiers reported the events to the chief priests. They were told to tell a lie – the disciples stole His body.</p>	<p>Mary, Mary &amp; Salome had bought spices after Sabbath ended.</p> <p>At dawn Sunday they came to the tomb talking as they went about who could roll the stone away.</p> <p>Upon arriving they saw the stone was gone. They entered the tomb and saw an angel who said "he is risen; he is not here...go tell his disciples...he will meet them in Galilee...." They left to tell them.</p> <p>Jesus appeared to Mary Magdalene. She went to the disciples who were mourning and weeping. She told them. They did not believe her.</p>	<p>Mary Magdalene came to the tomb while it was still dark on Sunday morning.</p> <p>She found the stone gone and ran to tell Peter &amp; John that someone had taken Jesus body.</p> <p>Peter &amp; John ran to the tomb, John stopping at the door, Peter running into the tomb.</p> <p>They saw the linen graveclothes and the face napkin. John believed.</p> <p>Mary [Magdalene] looked in and saw two angels. She said she didn't know where someone took Jesus' body.</p> <p>Jesus appeared to Mary. She went and reported these things to the disciples.</p>
