## JESUS & the OLD TESTAMENT

There was an underlying "current" or "idea" which was developed throughout the O.T. that God would send someone, an anointed one, who would manifest Himself to men and establish His kingdom on earth. This One appears throughout the O.T. with different titles: Seed of Abraham, Son of David, My Son, My Servant, Mine Elect, The Branch, Prince of Peace, Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father. Check these references: Genesis 22:18; 2 Samuel 23:5; Psalm 2:7; Isaiah 42:1; 9:6, 7; Zechariah 3:8; 6:12; Daniel 7:13, 14; 10:16-18.

The Jews in O.T. times regarded their Scriptures to be filled with references to their coming Messiah. Alfred Edersheim listed 456 of them that were listed in Rabbinic writings before the time of Jesus Christ.

- 243 from the Prophets
- 138 from the Writings
