Date: 7th month, 21st day - two months later

A repeat of history – Ezra 3:1-13

Our support system is still in place (2:5-9) – the Book, the Spirit & the Promised Return!

3. Confirm: Consider Your H

2:10-19

Date: 9th month, 24th day - two months later

A healthy person cannot pass their health to another. Yet, a sick person can pass their sickness to another. Learn of the influence of sin onto others! Doing right is always the way to blessing.

4. Assure: Consider Your V

2:20-23


Date: 9th month, 24th day – same day.
